Feed SHEEP MINERAL 15-5 as per ration recommendations from your local Clarence Farm Services Farm Consultant.

Using the scoop provided, feed up to one scoop per head per day to weaned growing lambs, mature ewes and mature rams. Each scoop provides approximately (1 ounce) 28 grams, the typical feed rate.

OPTIMIZE YOUR LAMB'S DIET

Clardigan Feed Services recommends you follow these management practices:

When changing roughages or grain rations, do so gradually. Allow 7 to 10 days for animals to adjust.

Offer high quality roughage and salt free choice at all times. Provide a source of clean, fresh water at all times.

Do not allow fine material to accumulate in feeders.

Provide adequate bunk space for each animal. Bunks should be protected and well managed to prevent feed from becoming wet or moldy.

Sheep Mineral 15:5 ABF should be fed from a sheltered feeder. Feed is perishable: Store in a dry, well-ventilated area protected from rodents and insects.

Do not feed mouldy or insect infested feed to animals as it may cause illness, abortion or death.

Sheep should be vaccinated against enterotoxaemia.

Consult your veterinarian for recommended health programs for your local area. This includes internal and external parasites.
